SAFETY CARD FOR A.A. GROUPS

Tradition Five: Each group has but one primary purpose, to carry its message to the alcoholic who still suffers. Anyone seeking help with a drinking problem is welcome here. No A.A. entity decides who is or isn't a member of Alcoholics Anonymous.

It is the conscience of this conference that if any person endangers another or

disrupts our efforts to carry A.A.'s message, the group may ask that person to leave.

We work hard to protect the anonymity of everyone here. But anonymity is not a cloak for unsafe or illegal behavior. Addressing such behavior, and contacting the proper authorities when appropriate, does not go against any A.A. Tradition. It is how we keep everyone safe.

Tradition One, short form: Our common welfare should come first; personal recovery depends upon A.A. unity. We want a room where alcoholics can focus on getting and staying sober.

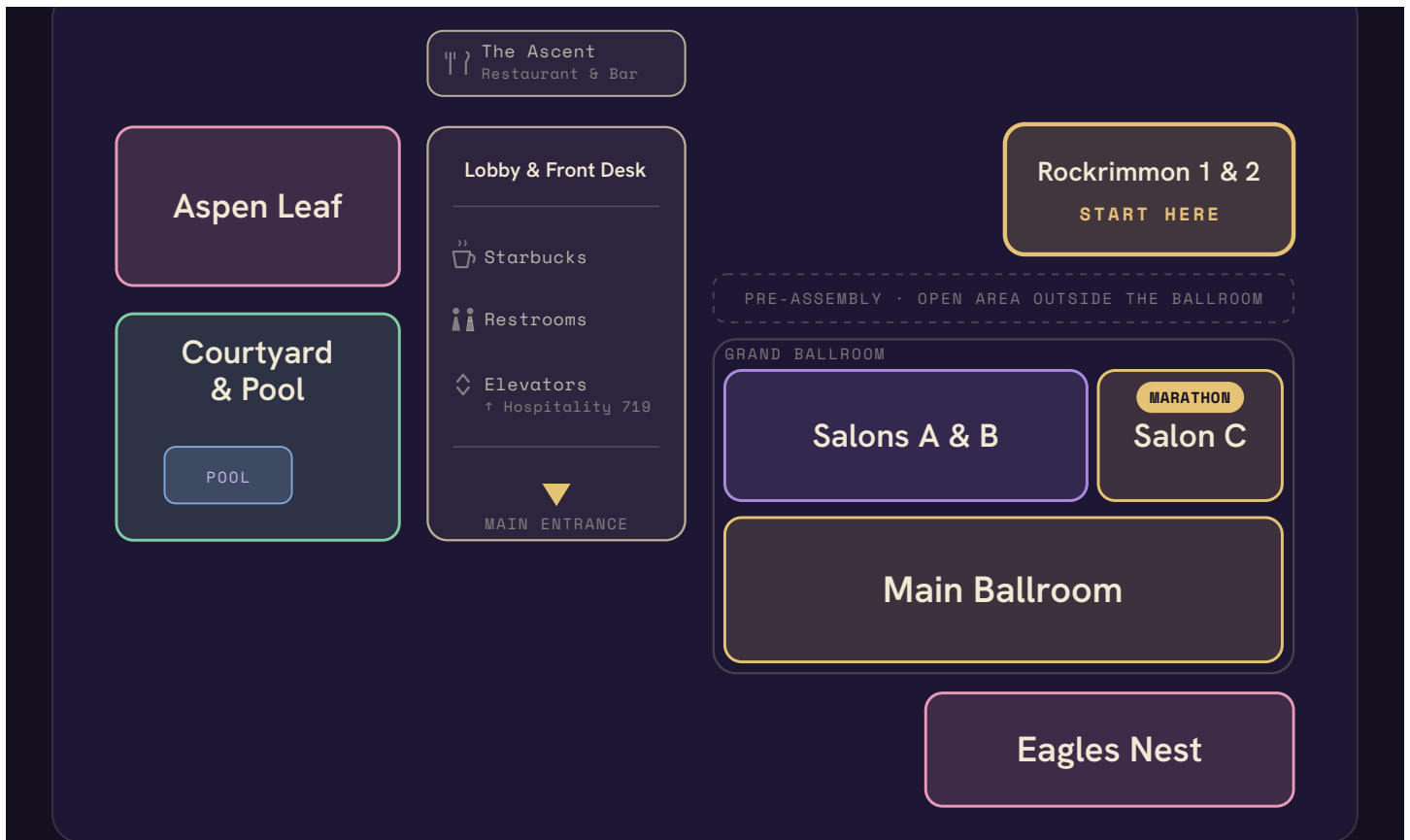

THE REGION

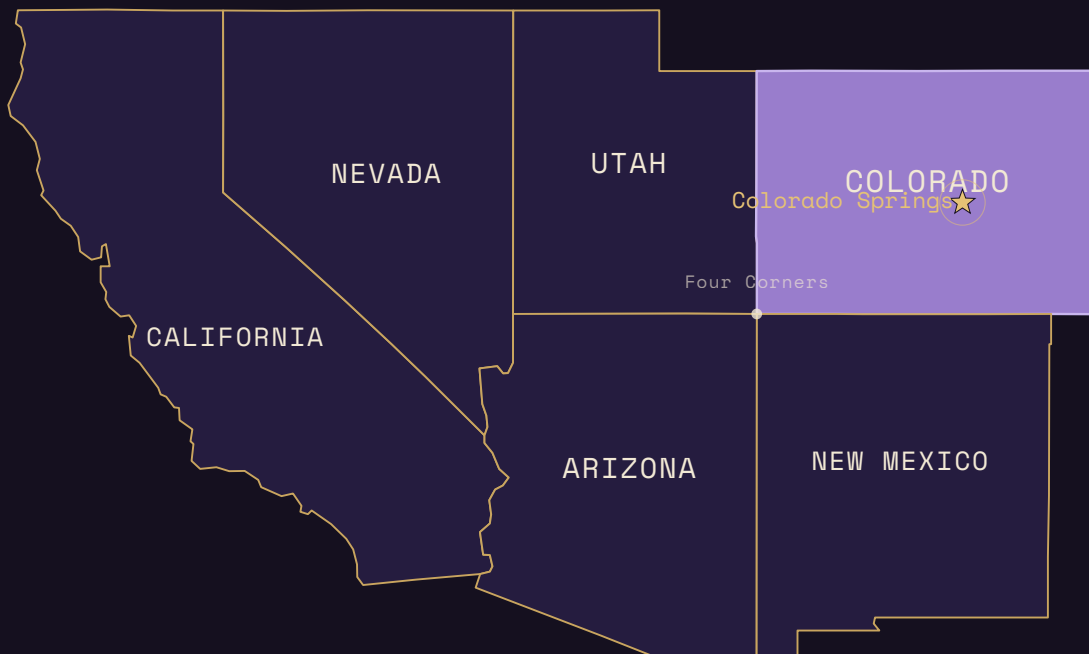
How we got here

SWACYCAA exists because a handful of young people kept driving across state lines to other conferences and wishing they could bring that feeling home. Between 2006 and 2010 there was almost nowhere in the Southwest within a day's drive to do that.

The Four Corners Summit started in 2010 to fill part of the gap, a small

annual campout for young people in recovery. It stayed small on purpose, and so the idea grew for something larger. In 2013, with the blessing of the WACYCAA Advisory Council, young people from Utah, Colorado, Arizona and Nevada met at WACYCAA in Tucson and formed a council to make it real.

It's been an annual gathering ever since, built so smaller cities with growing communities can experience attending, bidding, and one day hosting a conference of their own.



Six states, one fellowship. SWACYCAA moves around the Southwestern region, and this year it lands in Colorado Springs.

What's all the bidding about?

Some of the cities here are competing to host a future SWACYCAA. That's what the bid Q&As, round robins, and skits are for. If a city wins the bid, they carry the whole thing next year. Newcomers are welcome to watch it unfold.
